**CHILD PROTECTION CLUB POLICY STATEMENT**

The Werewolves of London Special Ice Hockey Club is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children, young people and vulnerable adults to play Ice Hockey.

We do this by:

- Recognising that all children and vulnerable adults have the right to freedom from harm.
- Ensuring that all our club officials and volunteers are carefully selected and accept responsibility for helping to prevent the harm of children and vulnerable adults in their care.
- Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of harm, by providing parents, children and vulnerable adults with the opportunity to voice any concerns they may have.
- Appointing a Club Child Protection Liaison Officer who will take specific responsibility for child safety, act as the initial point of contact for parents, children, vulnerable adults and outside agencies, and refer all issues and concerns promptly to the EIHA Regional Child Protection Officer.
- Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to the Club Child Protection Officer, Regional and National Child Protection Officer or the appropriate external authorities.
- Reviewing the effectiveness of the EIHA Child Protection Policy and activities in advance of the EIHA Annual General Meeting
